Kennett Square Farmers Market to Open Friday, May 14



Kennett Square, PA – May 5, 2010 – The Kennett Square Farmers Market is a seasonal favorite for Chester County residents to shop for local fruits and vegetables, Amish baked goods, cut flowers, potted plants, European breads, artisan cheeses, home-made jams and jellies, grass-fed meats and BBQ, and much more. The Farmers Market opens Friday, May 14 and runs every Friday from 2 to 6 p.m. through October.

Now in its 11th year, the Farmers Market also hosts live entertainment and specialty and craft vendors on the first Friday of every month, which coincides with the downtown's First Friday Art Stroll.

Shopping at the Kennett Square Farmer's Market is a great way to support local farmers. Buying directly from the farmer gives shoppers the opportunity to ask questions about the food, learn how it is grown, and appreciate the benefits of buying locally grown products.

The Kennett Square Farmers Market, a grower's market that coincides with the growing season, is located on the brick walkway next to the Genesis HealthCare building. Patrons of the market can conveniently park in the municipal garage accessible from N. Union Street. Exit the parking garage on foot through the glass doors directly into the market entrance.
