The Kennett Flash Presents John Eddie on Friday, April 30, 2010



Kennett Square, PA – April 14, 2010 – Singer-songwriter John Eddie brings his Memphis sound to the Kennett Flash on Friday, April 30 for two performances; 7 p.m. and 10 p.m. The Kennett Flash is located at 102 Sycamore Alley, Kennett Square, PA 19348. Residing in New Jersey, Eddie became a popular club performer there in the 1970s and then released his self-titled first album in 1986. Although frequently compared to Bruce

Springsteen, Eddie's sound is a unique blend of roots-rock with clear country, soul, folk, and rockabilly influences.

Eddie's performance quality and self-deprecating sense of humor on stage makes him an easy favorite of fans around the country, particularly in the Midwest and mid-Atlantic regions. In fact, Eddie attributes his professional longevity to his performances; "It's when I get in front of people that they really connect with my songs."

The tongue and cheek album title, *Who the Hell is John Eddie?* is Eddie's most recent compilation of songs that critics tout as his strongest work to date. Bruce Warren, assistant general programming manager for WXPB-FM 88.5 in Philadelphia called *Who the Hell is John Eddie?* an "instant hit" on the station. Eddie's music has his audiences stomping their feet, while he entertains them with his heartfelt lyrics and clever wit.
